## PET ADOPTION CONTRACT

TBD PET HAS BEEN SPAYED OR NEUTERED. ADOPTER acknowledges receipt of medical records as proof of PET'S sterilization, and THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION acknowledges receipt of \_\$ \_\_\_\_\_ adoption fee.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**In addition, ADOPTER agrees to the following terms and provisions:**

1. ADOPTER agrees to provide this PET with a safe home, proper care and attention, and humane treatment in accordance with all current and future state, county, and local laws and ordinances where ADOPTER resides. The PET is not to ride loose in the back of trucks, is not to be chained or tied-out, or allowed to run or roam loose. ADOPTER warrants that the PET will not be contained solely by a hidden or electric fence. The PET is not to be solely an outside pet nor housed outside in a kennel run, and ADOPTER agrees that when the PET is outdoors it shall be protected from the elements, provided with adequate food and clean water, and be safely confined when ADOPTER is away from home.
2. ADOPTER agrees to contact The Faith and Phoenix Foundation immediately if PET is lost, stolen, or dead.
3. ADOPTER agrees to take the PET to a licensed veterinarian at least once a year for an examination and routine vaccinations and tests, and to provide the PET with necessary veterinary care upon sickness, disease, and injury.
4. ADOPTER understands that there are costs involved in maintaining a PET, and agrees to assume full responsibility for the food bills, health care and licensing of the PET.
5. ADOPTER agrees to provide – at a minimum – the following vaccinations and tests at the intervals required by law and/or advised by their veterinarian: rabies, distemper/parvo combination, and a heartworm test followed by a regular course of preventative. Adopter agrees to keep the PET on Advantage or similar monthly flea and tick treatment that can be purchased only from veterinarians.
6. ADOPTER agrees that the PET will reside in his/her home, will be kept as a household pet, and will not be used for breeding, fighting, or exclusively as a hunting or guard PET.
7. ADOPTER agrees to provide a collar and a personal identification tag for the PET to wear at all times when allowed outdoors. ADOPTER also agrees to notify THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION within 24 hours should the PET become lost or separated from ADOPTER.
8. THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION makes no warranties or representations regarding the PET's health or temperament. It is agreed and understood by ADOPTER that while every effort is made to provide

an accurate history and assessment of a PET, THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION does not warrant any PET regarding medical status, behavior, or disposition. It is further agreed that environmental changes may effect and change the temperament of the above named PET and that THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION has no liability or responsibility of any nature regarding defects with the PET, or injuries or damage to any person or property which may be caused by the PET. ADOPTER agrees to indemnify and hold harmless THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION against any and all claims, known or unknown, now or hereafter arising in connection with this PET.

9. ADOPTER consents to the examination of this PET by THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION at any time and acknowledges that THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION has the right to reclaim the PET at any time for failure to comply with the terms of this contract or for any misrepresentation of fact ADOPTER made on the adoption application or in this contract. The Faith and Phoenix Foundation has the right to enter the ADOPTER's property and recover the PET if in the sole opinion of The Faith and Phoenix Foundation with the terms of this contract or for any misrepresentation of fact ADOPTER made on the adoption application or in this contract. In the event the PET should be returned or reclaimed by THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION, ADOPTER agrees to be financially responsible for any untreated medical needs of PET or unpaid medical expenses incurred while PET was in ADOPTER'S possession.
10. **ADOPTER agrees that, if for any reason he/she cannot keep PET, he/she shall return PET to THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION. ADOPTER understands that no refund will be given of the spay/neuter or other veterinary fees or adoption fee. The PET shall not be given away, sold, or exchanged without prior written consent of THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION. ADOPTER understands that anyone, including friend or family member, who wishes to take ownership of this PET will be required to apply to THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION for the right to adopt it.**
11. **Special Provisions: Neuter and Final Shots at 5 months of age paid by The Faith and Phoenix Foundation.**
12. It is agreed and understood by ADOPTER and THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION that this written agreement sets forth all promises, agreements, conditions, and understanding between them, oral or written, and that both parties have fully read and understood all of this agreement.
13. ADOPTER understands that this PET has the following behavioral concerns and acknowledges that ADOPTER has been informed of these concerns:
14. ADOPTER understands that The Faith and Phoenix Foundation is not selling the PET and any money given to The Faith and Phoenix Foundation is a contribution towards the work of caring for animals.
15. ADOPTER understands that this PET has the following medical concerns and acknowledges that ADOPTER has been informed of these concerns \_\_\_\_\_
16. ADOPTER agrees to immediately notify THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION of any name, address, home, work or cell telephone number or email address changes. ADOPTER's and CO-ADOPTER's true and correct current address, phone numbers, and email addresses are:
17. ADOPTER agrees to pay THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION for any and all expenses, including court costs and reasonable attorney's fees, in enforcing the terms and provisions of this contract. Payment of these damages shall not excuse ADOPTER from returning the PET to THE FAITH AND PHOENIX FOUNDATION.
